- To make the District an even better place to live!
















Official Community Plan (2011)









Transportation Plan








35% District resident trips in 2030 by walking, cycling or transit

- ✓ Car from 79% to 65%
- **✓** Transit from 10% to 15%
- ✓ Walking & cycling from 11% to 20%



Community Input

- Highest levels of priority
 - transit system is efficient, reliable and frequent
 - safer routes for children walking to school
- Relatively high priority
 - neighbourhood liveability is taken into consideration when road improvements are planned
 - reduce road collisions and improve traffic safety
- Generally higher priority on quality transit, neighbourhood liveability, and safety than on cycling connections
