# FONCVA Minutes March 21<sup>th</sup>, 2002

It was agreed that first order of business was to hear the:

## Bear Awareness Presentation by Betty Carrington

The presentation and Q/A lasted some 45 minutes. Information details can be obtained by phoning 604-990-BEAR (2327). Some 251 bear sightings were reported in 2001 (albeit a much smaller number of bears were actually involved). Most were from communities adjacent to the forested areas, creeks, ravines, etc. Only 2 bears were killed in 2001 as opposed to 40 in 1999. Educational program is key.

## 2. ADOPTION OF MINUTES

Correction to Feb 21<sup>st</sup> minutes – add Eric Andersen to attendees list.

Moved Dan Ellis/Cathy Adams -carried unanimously.

## 3. OLD BUSINESS

## 3.1 Budget Review Process -

General discussion ensued on the two public meetings. Some concerns and comments were expressed on the following issues:

- What is the actual status of the reserved funds?
- Why some council members did not stay for the whole time at either meeting?

- Some presentations were too lengthy; chair should ascertain the estimated time of presentations so short presentations can be interspersed between the longer ones? Questions from council to presenter sometimes lengthened the presentation.
- When the Provincial government passed on extra tax burdens in years past, council compounded the future problem by compensating from district reserve funds rather than increase taxes.
- Changes will have to be made as District has low growth and small industrial base.
- Some small cost measures were undertaken such as changing to a cheaper media provider and not filling vacated staff positions.
- Council has still not completed Budget Review process.
- It is felt that there are still areas where significant savings can be made -police, fire dept.

Proposed by Dave Sadler/Corrie Kost that we submit a letter of thanks to Council for granting the extra financial Budget Review meeting. Feb 27. – carried unanimously

**3.2 Community Charter** - Al Price was unable to set up a meeting with Ted Nebbeling as Ted would not

attend an evening meeting.

Corrie Kost/John Miller – We submit a letter stating disappointment that the meeting could not be arranged and that we would still welcome any future evening meeting if one could be provided by Hon.Ted Nebbeling – carried unanimously

### 3.3 Closed meetings of council and committees

 Two recent issues – one a simple grant application – dealt in open council meeting by CNV, another – the appointment to GVRD and Translink – again dealt in open council by Richmond, were both dealt with in-camera by District. This was felt to be in violation of Local Government Act. Corrie and others will pursue this.

## 3.4 Changes to Council Procedure Bylaw -

Mayor Bells' revision of Council Procedure Bylaw were adopted. FONVCA's proposed changes were not carried by council – being supported only by Councillors Muri and Crist. However the solicitor subsequently consulted on this issue agreed that public input of opinions and facts should be allowed. It was felt by FONVCA members that raising the issue for further debate by council had been worthwhile.

**3.5 Draft letter on "Approval of DVPs"**. Minor change of wording by adding "We believe" at

agreed sentences of paragraph 2 & 5. The revised letter is to be submitted to Mayor and Council.

## 4. CORRESPONDENCE ISSUES

**4.1 Business arising from extensive e-mail** – In light of a recently posted letter on the FONVCA web site a thorough discussion of the current policy of posting letters to FONVCA took place. The current policy is "all such correspondence will be posted, unless the author explicitly requests that it not be posted, or in the opinion of the secretary of FONVCA that it is inappropriate to do so." The intent being to avoid posting material that may be slanderous/libelous or contain inappropriate language. Corrie proposed to add that we "encourage content which enhances debate of the issues and not result in a flurry of adverse comments about its tone or "colourful" language".

This was rejected and instead Corrie Kost/Al Price moved and it was subsequently unanimously endorsed that we add the following preable to our current web site notice on posting letters –

The FONVCA site is intended to promote the free exchange of information and opinions. Messages sent for posting are encouraged to have content which enhances debate of the issues.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

**5.1 Bear aware presentation** – done above.

**5.2 Heritage Fund Principle** – It was proposed "That FONVCA support the principle that any excess of revenue over operational expenses for any Heritage Funded project be repaid to the Heritage Fund to cover principle and interest owed." Proposed Corrie Kost/Eric Andersen – carried unanimously. To be forwarded to council.

**5.3 Council GVRD and Translink Appointment Procedure.** It was moved/seconded by Corrie Kost/Diana Bellhouse "That FONVCA support the principle that discussions/nominations/election of GVRD and Translink appointments take place in an open public meeting of Council as is done in Richmond." This was carried unanimously. To be forwarded to council.

**5.4 Billboards** – general discussion took place on Councilor Denault's proposal to raise revenue for the District from proceeds by installing billboards on public property. The following concerns and comments were made:

• It goes directly against the OCP guidelines.

- What are the proposed locations for all these billboards?
- Property value loss could far exceed extra income.
- Draft sign by-law is ready, still to be bought to Council – possible public meeting before coming to Council?
- Could this put council into a potential conflict of interest?
- Is this the best deal?

Proposed by Maureen Bragg/Dan Ellis that the chair submit a letter to Council stating *"That while FONVCA appreciates Councillor Denault's efforts to find alternate sources of revenue from the private sector, we reject the installation of billboards on public property."* 

Carried unanimously.

## 6. OTHER BUSINESS

**6.2 Construction noise** – letter from District staff in response to our letter on construction noise suggesting alternative ways to control this problem. FONVCA to indicate to staff acceptance of the alternative.

## **RE: Private Funds For Public Structures / Facilities**

I am writing on behalf of the Federation Of N.V. Community Associations to express the collective concern of 13 community associations from Panorama Drive to Edgemont Village over the proposed initiative to permit the installation of billboards on public property in exchange for funding of capital projects.

At FONVCA's March 21<sup>st</sup> meeting this issue was discussed in detail, with some of the key points including:

- Billboards are contrary to the District's OCP.
- Proposed locations for all these billboards could well be in areas that do not directly benefit from the revenue.
- Billboards will cheapen the community.
- Loss in property value could far exceed extra income derived from billboards.
- Draft "Sign Bylaw" is ready but has still not been bought to Council is the public meeting on billboards preempting this new bylaw?
- Billboards on public property would place Council into a perceived conflict of interest because the temptation for extra revenue (with additional signage) may be too great to resist.
- Is the current proposal the best deal?
- Less intrusive forms of PPP should be pursued.

In light of the above discussion points, the following motion was carried unanimously:

"That while FONVCA appreciates Councillor Denault's efforts to find alternate sources of revenue from the private sector, we reject the installation of billboards on public property."

In reference to your March 18<sup>th</sup> letter to Mr. Bill Tracey of the Federation of NV Community Associations (File: 4020-20/01), I would like to offer the following response.

At the March 21<sup>st</sup> meeting of FONVCA, a discussion took place with respect to your proposed amendment to our original recommendation to harmonize the District's construction noise bylaw with that of NV City and West Vancouver District.

In light of the Municipal Solicitor's opinion on the matter, together with the practical realities of not wanting to prohibit residents from conducting home repair, maintenance or renovation on Sundays, FONVCA readily agreed to your suggested compromise to define "large-scale construction."

With the construction season beginning and residents wanting to spend more time outdoors in their yards, FONVCA hopes this item can be addressed in the relative short term.
