



This Project will provide a new overpass across the rail tracks to replace the existing at-grade Pemberton Avenue rail crossing just south of West 1st Street in the District of North Vancouver.

The new overpass is designed to improve traffic flow, reduce congestion and reduce noise from rail operations. The Project is one of several transportation infrastructure projects in the North Shore Trade Area and is jointly funded by all levels of government and local industry. **Construction is scheduled to begin this fall.**
