## PROJECT BACKGROUND:

In December 2014, a significant rockslide occurred in Seymour River Canyon approximately one kilometre north of Riverside Drive. This rockslide partially blocked the Seymour River and increased the water level upstream, flooding area trails and causing the need for removal of the Twin Bridge.

To ensure the trail network in the Seymour River Canyon continues to be both safe and accessible for recreational users, Metro Vancouver is in the early stages of gathering input on:

- a new pedestrian bridge across Seymour River
- new trail connections
- operational access to the east side of Seymour River.

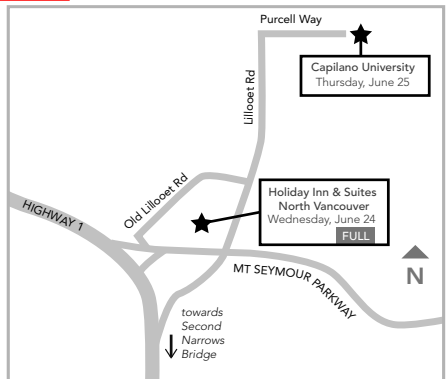
