The response is unacceptable.

An extensive study conducted by the UBCM determined that the use of the 5% counter-petition requirement was working properly, had never been abused by any disgruntled minority, and in fact was

already held to be too onerous for large municipalities (much less Regional Districts with a population of over a million voters).

The adoption of the term "alternate approval process" is a misnomer. The original term "counter-petition opportunity" is much more reflective of the true nature of this process. There is no "approval" aspect to this process.

It is our opinion that there was insufficient consultation on the matter of increasing the CPP from 5% to 10% and ample evidence that this % should have been reduced or at least maintained.

The application to a Regional District, requiring over 140,000 signatures, just to trigger a referendum by the entire 1.4 million voters in the GVRD, represents such an enormous requirement that we believe the courts would strike this down as being unreasonable.

History will show that not a single CPP will be successful due to this 10% threshold - thus making a mockery of the public's ability to have a say on significant issues between election.

It is a breach of good faith that a simple majority vote of council can now undedicate parkland which had been previously dedicated by referendum. Requiring those who wish to prevent the loss of their local dedicated park to muster up a petition of 10% of all registered voters across a region or municipality is far too onerous. This imbalance needs to be restored by requiring voter "assent" in order to undedicate parkland.

Dear Mr. Hunt:

I am writing on behalf of the *Federation of North Vancouver Community Associations* (FONVCA) regarding your "Evening Lecture Series" at the Learning Lodge in the LSCR.

I note that this lecture series has a "by donation" admission price, with a specific amount of \$7.50 for adults and \$4 for students and seniors clearly indicated on the brochure. You might recall FONVCA writing about this issue in December '03 (attached) when an admission fee was charged for a lecture at the Learning Lodge. In that letter we objected to any cover charge for citizens attending a public meeting in a public building on a topic of public interest with a speaker on the public payroll. Your response (also attached) indicated that the GVRD would move toward a system of voluntary contributions. It appears that the spirit of this intent is being violated by attaching a dollar figure to the donation.

One would logically think the GVRD would want to do everything possible to encourage citizens to be informed about important regional issues, and could therefore absorb any relatively minor speakers' costs associated with the lectures, two of which are by GVRD staff. Advertising that admission is by donation and then qualifying it with a dollar amount would appear to discourage citizen participation. After all, it is the GVRD as a whole that benefits through citizen education and participation in these important discussions.

You might remember the attached e-mail from September of 2003. The *Federation of NV Community Associations* raised the issue of a new liability insurance fee that was being charged to residents wanting to get together for a neighbourhood block party. At the time Council responded positively and the insurance fee was thereafter waived.

Fast forward to the summer of '05, we now discover that the Engineering Department is charging residents a \$25 permit fee for block parties. While \$25 might not seem like a great expense, it seems like an unnecessary obstacle. Are residents supposed to pass a hat around at the party to reimburse the person who paid the fee up-front at the Engineering desk? Is this fee really justified?

What FONVCA said about the liability insurance fee holds true for the cost of this new permit: "*FONVCA believes that rather than putting up obstacles like [a permit fee] in the path of residents wanting to organize social events, the municipality ought to encourage and assist residents in every way possible to hold block parties and thereby create and preserve healthy neighbourhoods. We therefore urge you to review this matter and remove the provision requiring fees for neighbourhood block parties.*"

RE: Liability Insurance For Block Parties

The *Federation of NV Community Associations* would like to draw your attention to the matter of the District charging a liability insurance fee for residents holding block parties.

For many years District residents have organized neighbourhood block parties where for a few hours a local road is closed and families get together for a barbecue and social interaction. These perfectly safe annual events contribute to building strong, healthy communities where people know and care about their neighbours. Without any consultation a change in policy this year resulted a \$50 liability insurance fee for block parties under 50 people and \$100 for gatherings over 50 people. According to the Engineering Department, this new policy has resulted in 50 percent fewer block party permits being issued this year. Is this really a productive policy if the result is to discourage residents from gathering together to socialize on their own streets?

FONVCA believes that rather than putting up obstacles like liability insurance in the path of residents wanting to organize social events, the municipality ought to encourage and assist residents in every way possible to hold block parties and thereby create and preserve healthy neighbourhoods. We therefore urge you to review this matter and remove the provision requiring liability insurance for neighbourhood block

parties.
