For comparison I had some trouble determining the schedules for say Vancouver finally found the Fitness schedules at <u>http://www.city.vancouver.bc.ca/parks/news/Fit_Hols_01.pdf</u> and Pool schedules at <u>http://www.city.vancouver.bc.ca/parks/news/Swim_Hols_01.pdf</u> The main link <u>http://www.city.vancouver.bc.ca/parks/community_centres/community_map.htm</u> was not well designed to indicate the above (need to click on "recreation", as the individual centres seemed to not readily supply the open-hours info). You will note a number of Vancouver centres

open all days for fitness with all pools closed only Dec25th.

Bottom line...not bad but there is clearly still room for improvement.
