The District Official Community Plan was adopted on November 18, 1991 - almost 10 years ago. I participated in the new District OCP process in 1996 & 1997. In April 1997, I received a draft copy of the Revised Official Community Plan for review. Since then, there has been no further communication or explanation as to why this process was abandoned. **Question:** Under whose authority was this decision made & why wasn't it announced to the public?

I regret that much time, effort & money has been wasted on this mammoth task by staff & the community alike in not following through in a timely manner. Volunteers sacrifice their valuable time to participate in these forums yet their efforts are wasted by District management, as clearly the process must start once again from scratch.

Question: What exactly is transpiring in regard to a revised District OCP? Moreover, by law I was under the impression that it is illegal not to review & update the Plan every 10 years. If work began tomorrow on this renewed task, it will take over one year to complete the process, well over the legally required time frame. **Question:** What are the legal requirements surrounding this issue?
