## Council Benefit Package

The last time Council voted themselves a raise, it caused much consternation amongst District taxpayers. It was regarded as unacceptable that elected officials should award themselves a pay increase. Oink! Oink!

Because of the hue & cry, Mayor Bell promised that this issue would be addressed in the future by referring the matter to a public committee whose decision would be accepted by Council.

Not surprisingly this promise has been broken. Following the trend of this Council to undermine the public process (Whey-au-wichen & Seymour Local Plan), disregard public opinion (Budget 2000 & Larco) and attack FONVCA (Federation of North Vancouver Community Associations), Council has voted itself a whooping raise.
