R.N.B. Dance & Theatre Arts already receives a subsidy in the form of a lucrative discounted rental agreement in leasing District premises at 3355 Mountain Highway. This Bylaw also exempts them from paying \$8000 in property tax. This provides an unfair advantage in competing with the other five dance schools on the North Shore.

I previously brought this issue to Council's attention which you chose to ignore & instead rubber stamped the recommendations.

There are <u>43 other properties receiving exemption</u>. Partial property exemption may be justified, but not 100%. **Everyone should pay their fair share for services provided.**
