Evidence to that effect is well documented. >> While denying her comments, Councillor Harris publicly rebuked > > Sadler for attributing those comments to her. > > As a consequence, Mr. Sadler obtained copies of the tapes of the two > > Council meetings in question & meticulously transcribed the relevant > > proceedings. Mr. Sadler then presented them to Council on April 2-2001 > > with a formal request for an apology from Councillor Harris, as the >> transcript clearly indicated that the Councillor did indeed make the
