

> NOTICE OF MOTION
>
> That construction on all major building sites in Lynn Valley be
> prohibited on every Sunday of every Month and that the District Bylaw be
> changed accordingly.
> RATIONALE:
> A past District policy, which prohibited major construction work on
> Sundays, was changed by the present Council at the behest of
> developers. The result is that they are now free to cause a noise
> disturbance on Sundays which, for many District residents is still a day
> of worship.
> By changing the old bylaw, which prohibited such work during all hours of
> Sunday, Council is infringing on the rights of people to have at least
> one full day of peace and to worship without being subjected to
> excessive noise as is the case in the Lynn Valley Core where such large
> scale construction is taking place and will continue for some time.
> Mr R. Gelling, a resident of Lynn Valley, a member of the Lynn Valley
> Community Association and a member of the Church located at 1341 East 27
> in Lynn Valley has written a letter which is enclosed, complaining that
> Sunday church services at his church were and are being disturbed by
> noise caused by adjacent construction work taking place on Sundays.
>
> The central question of this issue is that while to many the rights of
> developers to make such noise may be acceptable, to many it is not since
> it infringes on their constitutional right to worship in peace at least
> one day a week. That right is enshrined in law and is part and parcel of
> the Canadian Christian Tradition and Charter of Rights. Subsequently, the
```

> Bylaw should be changed to guarantee that right.
