      We abandoned westbound road closures yesterday to address the
> traffic problems we were experiencing. We made some changes to the
> Eastbound detour route, now using the New Dollarton alignment, changed
> some traffic signal timing, placed other traffic signals on Flash so
> Flagpersons could override them and we added several smaller direction
> signs.
>
      We began detouring Westbound traffic at 9:30AM today. I was on site
>
> for the lunch rush and so far, the changes have greatly improved the
> movement of vehicles through the site and in the Industrial area with no
> excessive backups. It appears that the slowest area is the intersection
> of Mt. Seymour Pkwy at Riverside Dr (East), but with the signal timing
> changes, the average wait is one signal cycle.
