Mr. Zerr:

I see from the District's "Outstanding Business List" that several items I thought should be on this list are not and/or their status is not indicated. One is the motion I made and which was passed by Council two years ago on the transfer of the Bylaw Offices from the RCMP building to the District Hall and the other is on " Road Repairs: Financial Impact on District Taxpayers".

The motion re "Road Repairs" is indeed listed on the "Outstanding Business List" but there is no indication as to its status "That staff be requested to provide a detailed report listing the total expenses to District taxpayers as a result of repeated road repairs such as opening and subsequent closures of roads to accommodate new development services requirements in and around the Lynn Valley Core construction areas". You may remember that one of my concerns was that the cost of these repeated openings and closures would be covered by our "DCC" charges as the case may be.

The motion was made on March the 11-2002. It is now the beginning of May 2002 and I would appreciate an indication as to when such a report will be forthcoming. I also believe that in all instances an

indication should be made on this "Outstanding Business List" as to when a resolution of relevant actions will be forthcoming.
