On July 8, I asked North Van District Council to hold a public inquiry regarding the new Dollarton road re-alignment in Seymour. Not only have they failed to address my request, I haven't even had the courtesy of an acknowledgement.

My inquiry concerned the lack of <u>due-diligence</u> by the District. Road construction commenced before the proper land assembly was complete. Instead of collecting interest in the bank, taxpayer money was tied up for over two years in two kilometres of useless asphalt, while the District waited for resolution to the 'missing link' of the Dollarton re-alignment by third parties.
