> A message from Ernie Crist:

>

> You may recall that a few days ago I stated via e-mail, that there will

> be no increase in recreation fees this year. I did so because, at a recent

> budget meeting, our Director of Recreation, Mr. Gary Young said so.

>

> However, Mr. Young has now sent me a message stating the following "At

> the District Budget Meeting last Wed I responded to a question from

> Councillor Dunsford who asked if we increased fees to offset the required

> 1.3% reduction in the 2002 budget. I responded NO".

>

> Mr. Young goes on to say - "The additional funds we found to offset the

> 1.3% came from increases in participation particularly in classes where we

> are closer to max participation within the capacity of the class room. Our

> overall participation in most programs increased again last year and

> continues to be higher than the population growth. At the District

> Budget Meeting presentation on Jan. 12th, our Chair, David Hobbs,

> indicated that we are planning a 3% fee increase in September to offset > inflation".

>

> In other words, contrary to the previous statement by Mr. Young, there > will be a fee 3 % increase after all.

>

> Sorry for the confusion - I simply took NO to mean NO - not 3% as appears

> to be the case now. Mr. Young, in his reply, also pointed out that the

> subsidy from the District was not close to \$ 6M as I had stated in my

> message but only \$ 5, 575, 000 which included

> \$ 775, 000 in 2001 for capital maintenance.

ADDITIONAL COMMENT

> Mr Young in his e-mail stated that I had also been wrong on the fee

> increases. I had stated that the increase had been 30 % plus 4 % across

> the board except for Seniors for whom the increase had been 50% plus 4%.

> Mr. Young pointed out that the 30% plus 4% increase was not across the

> board as I had stated but applied to fitness fees only, except that

> "fitness" fees for Seniors were 50% plus 4% -. sorry for the mistake.
> I always thought that "fitness" was what it was all about. Sorry.
>

So, Citizens, brace yourself for another increase unless of course you
 are willing to fight back.
