I want to express my disappointment in the manner that Council dealt with the Seymour Local Plan last Monday. In my opinion you have done an injustice, not only to the hard working volunteers of the local planning group, and the residents of Seymour, but also to all District residents and Councillor Doug Mackay-Dunn, whose absence from the meeting was used as an excuse to defer the simple endorsement of the questionnaire to be put to the public in a series of Seymour Local Plan meetings arranged for this week-end.
