> *Report Councillor Crist:*

> *That staff be requested to provide a report to Council on the feasibility
> of enacting a bylaw requiring gasoline stations in the District of North
> Vancouver to list the sulphur content of their gasoline, in a similar way
> that they list octane content.*

> *Rationale:*

> *Mr. Allan Robinson, a resident of the District, recently made a request to
> the Mayor and members of Council to enact a bylaw requiring gasoline
> stations in the District of North Vancouver to list the sulphur content of
> their gasoline, in a similar way that they list octane content. Mr.
> Robinson pointed out that he has great concern about air quality.*

> *The quality of the air in the region, despite a large GVRD bureaucracy
> employed to "monitor" it, is indeed deteriorating and ailments resulting
> from polluted air in the region, including asthma related diseases, are
> increasing. This is especially so in the case of children and older people
> who appear to be especially affected.*

>

> *It behooves the District of North Vancouver to at least investigate such a
> possibility as requested by Mr. Allan Robinson.. Listing the sulphur
> content in a manner visible to the public would undoubtedly contribute to
> public awareness of the problem. Raising public awareness is deemed to be
> the key in addressing the problem of pollution in the Region rather than
> adding to the number of bureaucrats as appears to be the traditional
> approach to addressing such issues.*
