Whereas there is community concern regarding full disclosure of election campaign donations;



That support for the above resolution by he Council of the District t of North Vancouver be forwarded to both the LMMA and the UBCM with a copy going to the Township of Langley

This motion is important for all municipalities. Councillor Crist has in the past proposed similar motions. In light of the last election held in the District of North Vancouver this motion is of particular consequence.
