> Notice of Motion - Report Councillor Crist:
> That all staff reports pertaining to DVP and or rezoning applications coming before
Council for consideration contain a short section indicating the official response to
such applications by the relevant community and or neighborhood associations.
>
> Rationale:
> Unlike other Municipalities where development in broad terms is GVRD, Council or
developer driven, in the District of North Vancouver it is neighborhood driven. This is
the result of the philosophy that community and neighborhood driven development is the
best guarantee that the concept of the sustainable community can be realized.
> Community driven development is not nimbyism but is the direct result of responsible
public participation in the physical, cultural and social development of the Community.
> In the District of North Vancouver this approach has led to great successes. Capilano,
Edgemont, Norgate, Seymour and Maplewood are but a few examples.
> This approach should be expanded also to DVP's and small scale rezoning applications in
a given neighborhood. This would project existing community associations to a higher
profile and prestige than is the case now - it would also give them a greater degree of
responsibility and thus add to the level of neighborhood democracy.
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
