In a by-lined article in the North Shore News of Sunday, April 27, writer Trevor Carolan urged readers to phone each of you.

The readers were asked to express their support for Mayor Bell and Councilors Harris and Muri, and to emphasize that they want "a Victoria-legislated resolution to the District's Canlan Catch-22 soon." Translation: Carolan wants the legislature to pass "enabling legislation" to retroactively legitimize what appears to have been an illegal contract approved by municipal council in 1998.
