Dear Mr. Sultan:

The Edgemont Community Association is concerned that many home owners in the Upper Capilano area who have heretofore received the full home owner grant are going to see it disappear or phase down in 2004 unless the grant threshold amount is raise above the current \$525,000. Specifically, residential property prices in North Vancouver have risen substantially in the past three years (on average 43%) and almost all recent detached sales in our local area are for a price in excess of \$525,000.

In the past the threshold amount for home owner grant eligibility has been raised in response to increases in assessed values of residential properties. We submit that, in view of the dramatic increase in prices during the past three years, it is time to raise the threshold amount again. If the threshold amount is not raised for 2004, it is likely that many middle class families and seniors in our area, who on fairness grounds should receive the grant, are going to see in disappear or phase down. In consideration of these facts, we therefore urge you to raise this issue with the appropriate officials within the Provincial Government.
