> Report
> That the existing Lynn Valley Library site on 27th and Mountain Highway be reserved to
build a Lynn Valley Community and/or Senior Center and that staff be instructed
accordingly.
> Rationale;
> There has been a massive reconstruction program in the Lynn Valley Core Area. This has
been done without creating any major community amenities. While substantial benefits
accrued to the developers, the public received no benefits.
> There was no sharing of the profits with the developers, as was possible - no provision
for community amenities such as a Community, Senior, Arts Center, or upgrading of
Recreation facilities in exchange for increased density and rezoning.
                                                                       Indeed the
District failed even to recoup the full cost for the enhanced infrastructure necessary to
accommodate the higher density.
> The District has sufficient Funds in the Heritage Fund, including from land sales both
actual and projected, to pay for the newly planned Library on Ross Road as well as the
commercial section of the Civic square if necessary. There is no compelling financial
reason for the District to sell the existing Library site. Instead of using the Heritage
Fund to cover operating expenses as continues to be the case and which, is strictly
speaking, illegal, as well as immoral and financially unsustainable, it should be used
for more appropriate and genuine capital purposes.
> The site is part of the Core Area and presents the District with an extraordinary
opportunity to provide the people of Lynn Valley with at least a modest but lasting
benefit in return for the higher density and the regional car traffic imposed on them.
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
