Mayor Bell;

I will not be able to meet with the "North Vancouver Harassment Inquiry Committee" until later this year. I had requested a 6 months time frame for preparing my defense, starting from the date of the issue of a press release on May 5, 2004, to what is clearly a continuation of harassment and witch hunt by Mayor Bell and Council.

I am also requesting legal assistance to the same degree as has been provided to staff and/or any person pertaining to this matter, be they in the present employ of the District or not.

Furthermore, I request free access to all documents on demand including correspondence both to and from the Customer Service and Quality Assurance Committee and other material as the case may be.

This is independent of the ability of any member of this Inquiry Committee to do so and may include copies of motions, correspondence, legal documents, minutes and email. This may include recorded protests against violations of procedure by the Mayor as well as copies of minutes and/or material pertaining to compensation to members of Council for expenditures in violation of Council procedure and without Council's knowledge, including documents indicating the presence of the Mayor acting as chair at such meetings in violation of the conflict of interest policy. I may also include documents pertaining to the KPMG, Northlands, Canlan, Heritage Fund and Infrastructure Reserve Fund issues.

It may also include documented complaints brought to the attention of the Mayor and/or the previous manager for providing misleading and /or false information to Council and the public pertaining to pertinent issues. It may also include for example copies of a motion requesting clarification on the dispensation of free Rec Commission passes to members of Council and their families, but not acted on by the Mayor, notwithstanding public statements on his part to do so.
