Subject: Police Prevent Multi Person Fight

Through information received, police set up a team of officers to intervene in a reported fight between a Korean gang and a Persian gang with an estimated 200 people to be in attendance bearing various weapons.

On December 11th, at approximately 7:30 pm, North Vancouver RCMP in conjunction with West Vancouver Police Department and Coquitlam Police Dog Services attended the said meeting ground at the Griffen skateboard park for the anticipated crowd. Police were in the area in various undercover and marked police vehicles. Undercover police witnessed a group of about 20 people arrive at the park and two of the subjects began to fight. Several police units moved in to assist and all subjects involved were arrested. No weapons were produced during the fight, but police believe it may have escalated into a larger fight given the opportunity. 22 subjects were arrested to prevent the continuation of the offense and to prevent injury, no gang related connections were found amongst those that were arrested. As they were all under the age of eighteen, they were all later released to their parents.

Seized from the incident were a set of brass knuckles, one mini strike bar and one pepper spray. North Vancouver RCMP are proposing one charge on the male found to be in possession of the brass knuckles. No other charges to date.
