Man witnessed in North Vancouver soliciting for the Cerebral Palsy Association and using a cash machine to obtain donations.

On October 20th, at approximately 7:15pm, North Vancouver RCMP received a call for service to the 3600 block of Baird Road . A male was going door to door soliciting for what he said was the cerebral palsy association. This male approached a home owner and asked her to donate and produced what looked like a remote control. The women said the man told her she could donate by using this machine and taking the money out directly from her account. She thought it seemed suspicious and did not give the man money, nor did she scan any bank cards into his portable machine. He then left on foot and she called the police. The cerebral palsy association confirmed that they do not canvass. Patrols for the suspect were negative.

Suspect description: Caucasian, late 50's, 5'9", 180lbs, thin grey hair, blue or grey jacket.
