> Your inquiry regarding the low level of Capilano Lake has been
> forwarded to me for response. You are correct in your assumption that
> the low lake level is due to GVRD work. They have lowered the lake
> level in order to repair seals on the dam drum gate, which is the
> mechanism that controls the level of water above the dam spillway.
>
> I spoke with the GVRD last Friday on this matter. They don't have
> serious concerns yet about the ability of the lake level to recover in
> time for summer, however it may be a problem should we have a dry
> spring. They will be monitoring the situation closely as spring and
> summer approach, and will keep municipalities informed of the water
> supply situation on an ongoing basis.
