On reviewing the material presented to council on the CFO Financial Workshop #6 (April 4/2005) I must take exception to the stated 2.51% average annual growth of per capita tax over 10 years. The value would be SIGNIFICANTLY higher if:

- the data considered was from 1995-2005 instead of 1993-2003
- the transfer of fees from the tax base to utilities were taken into account

Of course this does not tell the whole story.

- depletion of reserves
- draining of heritage funds
- huge increase in debt load
- insufficient funding of capital maintenance etc.
