Robbery Foiled By Inquisitive Cashier

Early this morning at approximately 05:00am the Chevron gas station, located at 1490 Main Street in North Vancouver was the scene of an attempted robbery. Two males walked into the station and passed the lone male employee a note which stated, "Hand over all of the money or else I'll kill you". The inquisitive employee asked the two males if they had a gun? The two males, obviously a little perplexed by this line of questioning, simply looked at one another. The employee locked the doors to the store and picked up the phone to call for police. At that point the two would-be robbers realized that they were in over their heads and fled from the store after booting the locked doors open. The were last seen running north on Mountain Highway. North Vancouver RCMP as well as a police dog handler arrived on scene shortly after the phone call from the employee but the suspects were not found. It is believed that the suspects had a vehicle.

The entire incident was caught on video surveillance, and the note has been seized by police for fingerprinting. The two suspects are described as follows:

SUSPECT #1 Asian male, 5 foot 6 inches tall, slim build, wearing dark clothes sunglasses SUSPECT #2 Caucasian male, 5 foot 8 inches tall, dark sunglasses, head band.

Both suspects were described as young males, 20 years old or younger. Also both had bandanas over their mouth area.
