Subject: Shooting in Lynn Valley

Last evening, just after midnight the North Vancouver RCMP received numerous calls of possible gunshots that were heard in the area of 3100 Milton Avenue in the Lynn Valley area. Police responded to the scene and cordoned off the area to conduct a search. Police dogs were brought in as well to assist the members in the search. Witnesses in the neighbourhood had observed a car speeding away after hearing the shots. The vehicle could only be described as a white, four door car.

While police were at the scene questioning neighbours about the gun shots, a male was reported to have arrived at the Lions Gate Hospital's emergency room with two gun shot wounds. Police attended to speak to the victim, who is known to police. Details are still being investigated about what specifically occurred and cooperation with police is limited at this time, but it is believed that the victim police interviewed was involved in the shots that were heard on Milton Ave. The wounds are not considered serious. It is not believed to be a random attack.
