Whereas as a result of this request speed bumps were installed but were later removed because some residents objected to them and also because the District of North Vancouver promised to build sidewalks and

Whereas the District for lack of funding has failed to adequately install such sidewalks while continuing to subsidise the City of North Vancouver via the present Recreation Commission agreement and

Whereas the District of North Vancouver in addition has and/or continues to siphon off millions of dollars from its Heritage Fund and Infrastructure Reserve Funds while taxes have gone from one of the lowest in the region to one of the highest and

Whereas the interest and safety of District residents must take precedent before the interests of another political jurisdiction such as the City of North Vancouver and other projects such as building and maintaining trails for Mountain Bikers in District Parks by way of example

Therefore be it resolved that the District provide adequate funding in the 2005 budget for the installation of sidewalks and other traffic calming devises as was promised to the people of Riverside Drive several years ago.
