> Whereas Linda Watson, President of the North Vancouver's Teachers
> Association, on behalf of the Teachers of North Vancouver has
> requested that the Council of the District of North Vancouver use its
> influence and assist the teachers in bringing about an end to the
> present dispute with the provincial government and

> Whereas the principle approach of resolving this matter is the
> earliest resumption of negotiations between the two parties and
>
> Whereas the Teachers have indicated that they are willing to sit down
> with the provincial government in an attempt to bring an end to this
> dispute and

> Whereas the continuation of this dispute is detrimental to the
> interests of the children, the teachers and the public in our
> community and

> Whereas the District of North Vancouver has a large stake in the well
> being of all of our citizens

> Therefore be it resolved that the Council of the District of North
> Vancouver send a letter to the Premier of British Columbia, the
> Honourable Gordon Campbell, asking him to resume negotiations with
> the representatives of the Teachers and based on fairness and good
