I am writing you as the President of the Boundary Community School Association and a very concerned parent and resident.

There is little or no markings at the intersection of 29th and Williams. This is a very heavily used intersection for Boundary and Argyle students. The lines on the road are no longer visible and there is no Pedestrain Crosswalk warning signs on William or 29th.

With the growth in Lynn Valley this intersection is becoming increasingly busy and as a result dangerous. The recent car accident last week is a result of the poor markings at this intersection. Cars run the stop signs on 29th on a daily basis. Cars going east on 29th and turning south on Willaim do not stop at the corner and continually run the stop sign. I know of several children who have been nearly hit while crossing at this corner.

This intersection needs better signage and possibly some kind of traffic calming plan before a child is seriously injured or killed. This intersection has gone from a crossing guard to non-existent markings while the traffic and population has dramatically increased.

On behalf of the residents, Argyle and Boundary Students, I urge the District to improve this intersection before a tragic accident happens.
