We would like to let your community members know about the opportunity to meet with plant managers of Canexus, ERCO Worldwide and Dow and discuss the operation of their chemical facilities on the North Shore waterfront near you. These industries sponsor a Community Advisory Panel (CAP) where community members can meet directly with plant managers and the North Shore Emergency Management Office to discuss concerns or provide input on the plant development and operating activities. The objective of the Panel is mutual awareness-raising for both plant operators and community members and continuous improvement of plant operations to ensure a safe and healthy community environment. The Panel is not a formal decision making body but rather a forum for information exchange and planning. The records of the CAP discussion are audited to evaluate the company's performance on community responsiveness, as part of their commitment to the Responsible Care code of practice for chemical industries.

We would like to ensure that community members with an interest in the responsible operation of these facilities are aware of the opportunity to participate on the CAP. We would appreciate any assistance you could provide in distributing this information to your community members.
