Dear Sir/Madame:

On behalf of the residents of the Lynn Valley Co-Op residing in the 25 hundred block on Fromme Road, we request that the Council of the District enforce existing DNV bylaws to ensure that the roads adjacent to the construction site on Whiteley Court be kept clean of mud and debris emanating from the construction site and that trucks and other construction equipment be hosed down before leaving the site.

At present the bylaw is clearly not being enforced sufficiently resulting in mud and dirt being spread over adjacent roads in Lynn Valley much to the inconvenience and expense of local residents and other people travelling on those roads.

There is no proper crosswalk area patrolled by a flag person to ensure our seniors safety crossing the road. As well on the weekend the crosswalk area was left with a gravel topping that quickly eroded into a pot holed mess with no posted warning signs and cars were bottoming out into the pot holes.

We would be remiss in not also pointing out that the seniors residing in the Kiwanis Towers in our immediate neighbourhood many of whom we know personally are also all very much affected by this.

We look forward to an immediate resolution and hope to hear from you quickly. Thank you.
