At present the bylaw is clearly not being enforced sufficiently resulting in massive mud and dirt being spread over adjacent roads in Lynn Valley much to the inconvenience and expense of local residents and other people travelling on those roads.

We would be remiss in not also pointing out that the seniors residing in the Kiwanis Towers in our immediate neighbourhood many of whom we know personally are also all very much affected by this.
